Art in the Cemetery A Q&A with Melanie Marks

Perhaps the most interesting gravestones in America are those from the 1600s-1700s, found in New England cemeteries. Many of our Merwin ancestors' graves are marked by such stones, replete with ghostly images of death and other interesting symbols. These ghostly images reflect the Puritan view of death. The accompanying symbols often say something specifically about the deceased.

Our speaker at the July 16th Miles Merwin Association reunion, Melanie Marks, will explain "New England Gravestone Art" following our luncheon at The Milford Yacht Club. Ms. Marks, a veteran historic preservationist, lives on an 18 acre farm in Fairfield, a farm which dates back to 1785. For Milestones readers, we asked Ms. Marks several questions, in anticipation of her presentation.

Q: How did you become interested in tombstone art?

A: *I had been researching historic Connecticut houses and their related genealogy with the intent of listing the homes on the State Register of Historic Places. Along with getting the houses listed, I was instrumental in securing the listing of Westport's oldest burying ground as well. Due to this research I found myself totally fascinated with these earliest gravestones and cemeteries. Who carved the gravestones? What do they represent?*

Q: That's certainly a different hobby. You must have developed quite a reputation.

A: *I have been called "The Cemetery Lady." Phone calls from my kids usually start with "What cemetery are you in today Mom?" I joined the Connecticut Gravestone Network five years ago and started learning to restore, reset and repair these historic treasures. Historic tombstones can be found dotted all across Connecticut. Some stand proudly within church yards. Some can be found along less traveled roads, while others are located on the edges of family farms.*

Q: It looks like what started out as a hobby has become a business.

A: *It has. Three years ago I started my own company, Connecticut House Histories, LLC. I felt I'd be viewed more as a professional, as opposed to a "house hugger," as some people outside "The Preservation World" like to call us. I have been instrumental in completing historical and genealogical research for 52 houses. Fifteen now are listed on the Connecticut State Register of Historic Places. These houses and historic cemeteries are the fabric of what makes our New England towns so special. Preserving and protecting them has become central to my life.*

William H. Aiken born June 2, 1926, died on June 27, 2009 in Glens Falls, New York. He was the husband of Ruth Merwin Aiken.

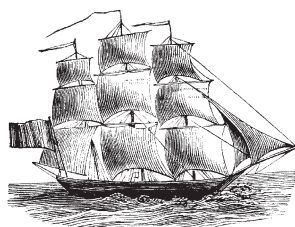
Website Update
